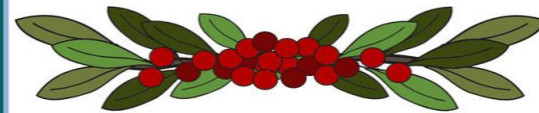
**From Administration**



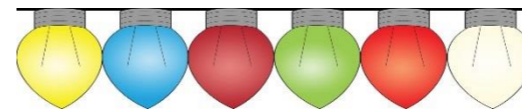
