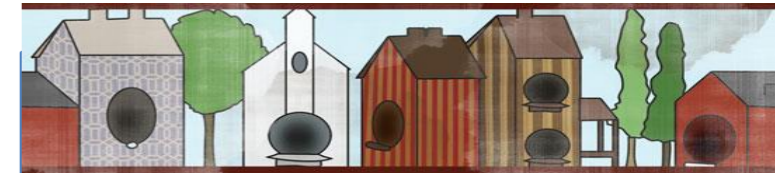
LTC NURSING
