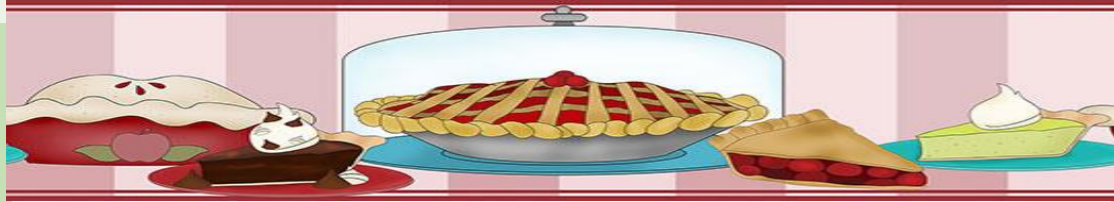

**From Administration**

In January, the Retirement home went into Outbreak with Influenza A & B. As of January 22 we are officially out of Outbreak per the Health Unit. While we don't close the home when we are in outbreak, we do change some of our routines. Here are some of the things you may notice in an Outbreak of Influenza.

Residents who are ill will be asked to stay in their room to help prevent the spreading to all Residents. Meals will be delivered to their room. If you are visiting your loved one we ask that you visit them only. Some of our activities are changed or cancelled for the safety of all Residents.

If you haven't had a flu shot, the choice is yours to visit or not. Again we ask that you only visit your loved one to help limit exposure. It is not too late to get our flu shot at your local pharmacy.

We post signs on our doors when we have active influenza. You can call us at 519-455-3910 to get a status on a Resident or ask about any precautions.
