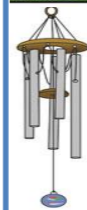
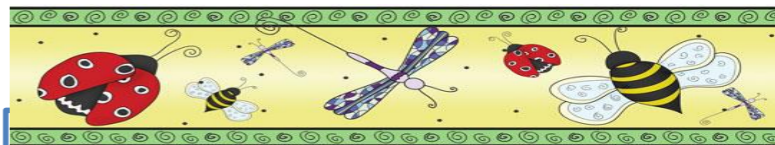
Just a reminder that all room rates will be increasing as of July 1st, 2017.
