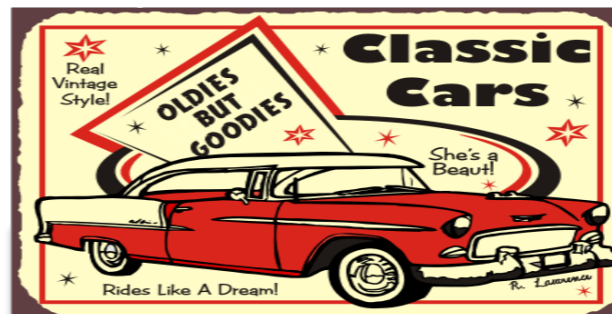

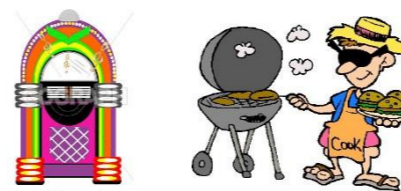

### TIPS FOR BOOKING MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS

- \* If you book an appointment for a resident, please let the nursing staff know about it several days in advance so any paperwork or prep work can be done properly.
- \* Family are responsible for arranging transportation to and from appointments. If nursing staff books a test or appointment ordered by the physician, they will call you to arrange transportation. Voyageur Transit is available at a cost and must be arranged by family as they require a credit card number or a cheque at the time of pick-up.
- \* CCAC does not normally notify the home of pre-existing appointments made for the resident prior to admission. Family is expected to notify the home of the date and time of appointment.
