Nurse Practitioner in Long Term Care

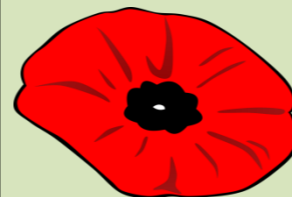

The attending nurse practitioner will address the complex care needs of residents by delivering and coordinating services including:

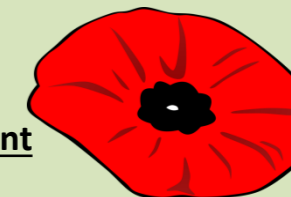
- Proactive assessments and screenings

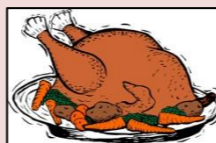
