Give

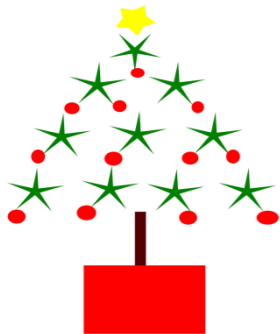
