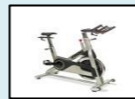




Life Mark News

Behavioural Supports Ontario (BSO) recognizes that **all behaviour has meaning** and that responsive behaviours are often a form of communication of an unmet need for an older adult living with dementia, complex mental illness, substance use and/or other neurological disorder.

Examples of responsive behaviours include but are not limited to:

- Hitting
- Grabbing onto people
- Pushing
- Throwing things
- Biting
- Scratching
- Spitting
- Hurting self or others
- Tearing things or destroying property
- Sexually expressive behaviours
- Negativism
- Kicking
- Pacing
- Trying to get to a different place
- Eating/drinking inappropriate substances
- Hiding/ Hoarding
- Performance repetitious mannerisms
- General restlessness
- Screaming
- Cursing
- Repetitive sentences or questions
