The Ministry of Health and Long Term Care are currently in the home (since the end of April) for their Annual Resident Quality Inspection. Once completed we will provide resident and families with the results from their inspection.

#### Summer Months:

**CLOTHING:** as we move into the warmer weather, we ask families to sort through the clothing to remove winter clothing items and/or items which are not in good repair or no longer fits or is serviceable to the resident.

All new clothing items brought into the Home must be entered onto the Resident clothing list, and left at the nurses' station for labeling.

#### Air Conditioning Units:

Families are welcomed to bring in A/C units for their relative. Units previously used must be serviced prior to being brought into the Home—this includes checking of the system and cleaning of the filters. A/C's can be a source of Legionnaires Disease if not properly maintained.

#### Food Items:

We encourage families not to bring in food items and leave in rooms unless the items are in sealed containers –crumbs, liquid spills etc. can be a source of attracting ants and other little pests.

Please do not bring in any food item(s) which can spoil quickly in the heat.
