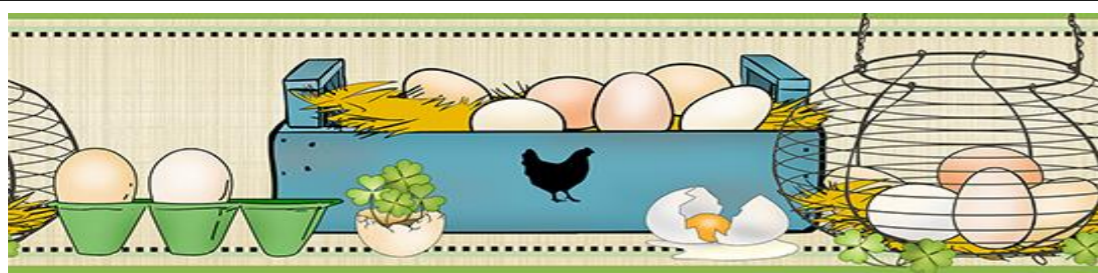

February has certainly been unpredictable for weather, let's hope that as March begins we start to see a little more sunshine.

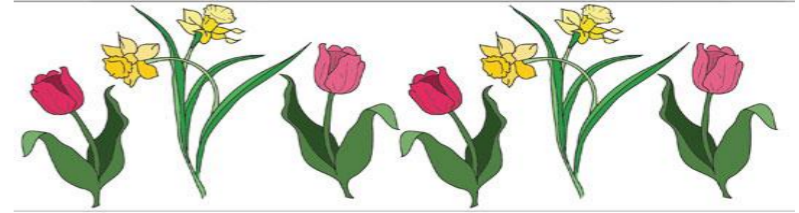
With the unpredictable weather comes flu like symptoms, we have been very fortunate that our residents have remained healthy during this flu season.
